Career Hotspot ... Chemical Engineer

Chemical engineers design and coordinate the construction and operation of manufacturing facilities and processes which convert raw materials into everyday products such as petrol, toothpaste, pharmaceuticals and plastics.

Personal Requirements:

- enjoy technical and engineering work
- · safety conscious
- able to identify, analyse and solve problems
- good communication skills



- good at computing and design
- practical and creative
- Able to work independently and accept responsibility.

Education and Training:

To become a chemical engineer you usually have to complete an engineering degree at university with a major in chemical engineering or industrial chemistry.

Alternatively, you can complete a relevant degree at university, followed by a postgraduate qualification in chemical engineering. To get into the degree courses you usually need to gain your HSC/ACT Year 12. Prerequisite subjects, or assumed knowledge, in one or more of English, mathematics, biology, chemistry and physics are normally required.

Employment Opportunities:

Major employing industries include manufacturers of iron and steel basic products, manufacturers of organic industrial chemicals, and the minerals industry and petroleum refiners. There is also scope for chemical engineers to move into related areas such as biotechnology, food engineering and mineral engineering.

Others are employed by government agencies assessing and monitoring the risk and impact of chemical processes on the environment (checking air and water quality, for example). Those who have built a reputation through working in the industry for several years may become consultants with engineering firms or on a self-employed basis.

Apprenticeship Program

The Apprenticeship Program is essential for developing and retaining the highly skilled maintenance workforce needed to ensure bus reliability for the community.

As an Apprentice you will undertake on-thejob & State Transit specific technical training while also completing a trade qualification with a Registered Training



Organisation (RTO). Apprentices are supervised, trained and mentored on a daily basis at the depot by qualified trade staff and Managers and receive ongoing mentoring, management and support from Fleet Operations Division.

From the start of your second year, part of your training will involve rotating to other State Transit depots. Each rotation is for six months and ensures you gain experience across the diverse State Transit fleet.

You have the opportunity to undertake additional trade competencies throughout your apprenticeship.

Heavy Vehicle Mechanic Apprentices service, maintain and repair automotive systems including:

- Engines
- Brakes
- Steering and suspension
- Transmissions
- Cooling
- Electrical
- Fuel air systems

This work is undertaken using electronic manuals and diagnostic aids to help identify faults.

Heavy Vehicle Body Repairer Apprentices maintain and repair our bus fleet including:

- Determining vehicle damage and repair procedures
- Repairing corroded panels and components including rust and fibreglass repairs
- Panel fabrication and welding
- Repairing accident damage, including straightening frames
- Installing and fit out of floor coverings
- Paint rectification and touch up work
- Removing and replacing bonded panels and windows
- Seat repairs and replacements
- Repair and servicing destination mechanisms
- Change out programs

Being a Heavy Vehicle Apprentice can be a physically demanding job. To ensure you can meet the physical demands of the job you will undertake a medical assessment as part of the selection process.

Competitive wages and excellent working conditions are offered.
