- 3. The audition will be a maximum of 10 minutes. During this time your son will be required to play two contrasting pieces: one displaying technical ability and the other demonstrating interpretive skills such as an ability to play long, sustained lines, dynamic contrasts and phrasing. Your son's instrumental teacher should be able to advise you on repertoire which will fulfill these requirements. If you son is also auditioning on a second instrument, he should prepare one piece only on this instrument. Some aural test may also be given.
