- There is no application fee
- You will be required to meet the <u>co-curricular or service requirement</u> we have adjusted our requirements due to the disruptions of COVID-19, please review the updated co-curricular or service schedule
- You will apply for admission, guaranteed accommodation, and over 200 scholarships all in one application

University of Sydney Mathematics Prerequisites

The University has <u>mathematics course prerequisites</u> for some courses. This means that to study certain degrees, students will need to achieve a Band 4 in the NSW Higher School Certificate (HSC) Mathematics (not general mathematics) or <u>equivalent</u>.

- If students don't meet the mathematics requirements, they may be able to:
- complete the Mathematics MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) and exam
- apply for another course and then transfer into their preferred course in their second year (after successful completion of an accepted 1000 level mathematics unit).

UCAT ANZ for Medicine and Dentistry in 2022

The University Clinical Aptitude Test is a compulsory test that you may have to sit in order to apply for some degrees in the fields of Medicine or Dentistry.

Designed to help universities to select applicants the appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required to practice successfully as a doctors or dentists. It is used in collaboration with other admissions processes such as interviews and academic qualifications.

13 of the <u>universities</u> in Australia offering Medicine and Dentistry, and 2 in New Zealand, will require you to sit the UCAT ANZ test as part of your application. So, if you're thinking of applying to uni in 2022 for a degree in one of those fields, you should check the entry requirements as soon as possible to find out if taking the UCAT ANZ is necessary.

Registrations for concession and access schemes are open now. **Bookings open on 1 March 2021 and close on 17 May**. You'll sit the tests between 1 July and 11 August 2021. Results will be delivered to the universities in early September.

It costs \$305 to sit the test (\$199 concession fee, but you only have until 10 May to register for concession prices).
