- Completed Australian Year 11 or International Baccalaureate Year 11
- Currently completing Australian Year 12 studies in 2021 or an International Baccalaureate Diploma in November 2021
- Applying for an undergraduate program that starts in 2022

If this does not apply to you, <u>learn more</u> about the application process that matches your qualifications.

What you need to know:

- Offers released on 9 August 2021 are based on your Year 11 results and these will be honoured for study in 2022 as long as you complete Year 12 and achieve an ATAR
- If your Year 11 results don't meet entry requirements, we will automatically consider your Year 12 results in the December offer round
- There is no application fee
- You will be required to meet the <u>co-curricular or service requirement</u> we have adjusted our requirements due to the disruptions of COVID-19, please review the updated co-curricular or service schedule
- You will apply for admission, guaranteed accommodation, and over 200 scholarships all in one application

<u>University of Sydney Mathematics Prerequisites</u>

The University has <u>mathematics course prerequisites</u> for some courses. This means that to study certain degrees, students will need to achieve a Band 4 in the NSW Higher School Certificate (HSC) Mathematics (not general mathematics) or <u>equivalent</u>.

- If students don't meet the mathematics requirements, they may be able to:
- complete the Mathematics MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) and exam
- apply for another course and then transfer into their preferred course in their second year (after successful completion of an accepted 1000 level mathematics unit).

Applying for ADFA is a competitive, dual application process that can take up to 12 months. It's preferable you apply in Year 11, but you can still apply in Year 12.

You can choose from a range of <u>UNSW degrees</u>, each of which leads directly to an officer role in the Navy, Army or Air Force. You will also need to ensure you are eligible.

UCAT ANZ for Medicine and Dentistry in 2022

The University Clinical Aptitude Test is a compulsory test that you may have to sit in order to apply for some degrees in the fields of Medicine or Dentistry.

This is designed to help universities to select applicants, and the appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required to practice successfully as a doctors or dentists. It is used in collaboration with other admissions processes such as interviews and academic qualifications.

13 of the <u>universities</u> in Australia offering Medicine and Dentistry, and two in New Zealand, will require you to sit the UCAT ANZ test as part of your application. So, if you're thinking of applying to university in 2022 for a degree in one of those fields, you should check the entry requirements as soon as possible, to find out if taking the UCAT ANZ is necessary.

Registrations for concession and access schemes are open now. Bookings open on 1 March 2021 and close on 17 May. You'll sit the tests between 1 July and 11 August 2021. Results will be delivered to the universities in early September.

It costs \$305 to sit the test (\$199 concession fee, but you only have until 10 May to register for concession prices).
