HSC Patterns of Study

HSC plus ATAR:

Ranking for university applications

HSC plus Vocational

- HSC plus opportunities for industry based and competency based learning that prepares students for TAFE and apprenticeships. Some students will also consider university in the future.
- Qualifications such as a boat license or a white card



To be awarded the HSC

- Satisfactorily complete all courses (attendance, attitude, behaviour...)
- Complete ALL course components (major works, performance, exams, work experience, competencies)
- Complete ALL assessment tasks
- Sit for and make a serious attempt at the HSC Examinations



How many subjects?

- 12 units minimum for the Preliminary Course (many students study 13 units).
- English and Religion are compulsory.
- HSC plus Vocational students must select 7 subjects as their first preference.
- HSC plus ATAR students select 6-8 subjects as their first preference.
- You need 2 reserve subjects as we cannot always guarantee first choices due to timetabling/ numbers constraints



Consideration in Course Selection

Make realistic choices, which reflect your interests, capabilities and talents.

Gentlemen ask yourself:

- What subjects am I good at?
- What subjects do I enjoy?
- What do I want to do beyond school?
- Which subjects are important and related to my career options?
- Am I sufficiently prepared to handle these subjects?



Consideration in Course Selection

Factors that should be ignored include:

- Attempting / not attempting a subject because you like / dislike a particular teacher.
- The course patterns of your friends.
- It looks easy.
- It scales up.
- I'll drop it after Year 11.
- Couldn't think of anything else.



Processing of Preliminary Subject Indications

The College reserves the right of placement of students in courses in cases where:

- Demand does not justify the running of a course. In some cases, composite classes may be created.
- There is **excess demand** for a course for which the College has no capacity to provide extra classes.



Processing of Preliminary Subject Indications

The College reserves the right of placement of students in courses in cases where:

- The degree of difficulty of the course is deemed beyond the demonstrated ability of the candidate that is evidenced by Year 10 results.
- Consequently, all application forms received by the College are considered 'preliminary indicators', until such time as all the information regarding individual students and total course demand is available.


