## **Spectators / Parents**

- 2 spectator parent / guardians per player at outdoor fixtures at Queens Park
- 1 spectator parent / guardian per player at indoor fixtures and tennis or any other fixture on Waverley College campuses also dependant on capacity of venue
- Social distancing will be enforced by Covid marshalls
- Face-masks are required for all adults
- No parents at any training sessions
- Entry to the Waverley College Senior Campus on Saturdays will be via Gate 9A only (adjacent to the Performing Arts Centre) on Birrell St.
- QR coding for all players and parents who come on Waverley property and at Queens Park
- QR coding for parents who attend external venues
- Only 1sts players using the changerooms at Queens Park and in the Gymansium
- Toilets will be accessible
- No canteen facilities will be provided for Saturday February 5.
- All equipment used in regularly sanitised as well as hand sanitisation stations in use

- No player, coach or parents should be attending if displaying flu-like symptoms, are a close contact or have been asked to isolate and must seek urgent medical advice
- No parking will be available on campus
- Queens Park Pavilion will on be accessible for players and coaches

## Players / coaches

- Each school looks after their own equipment and equipment is not to be shared where possible
- Standard 1.5m social distancing on sidelines
- No player, coach or parents should be attending if displaying flu-like symptoms and must seek urgent medical advice
- QR Codes will only be able to be accessed on Saturdays at each venue
- Change rooms will only be in use for 1sts teams
- All schools need to keep an accurate record of players and coaches attending
- All players and coaches must depart immediately at the conclusion of their matches and there will be no after match functions
