## Important Bus Arrangements and School Bag Arrangements

# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EVENING**

1. When students are in the stand, there must be one student per seat - there is to be no crowding around the balconies or stairways aisles. The first row is to be kept vacant for the College Prefects.
