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Day 1: South Africa, Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve

Welcome to South Africa! On arrival at Skukuza airport you will be met and transferred to Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge. After check-in and lunch (arrival time dependent), spend some time familiarizing yourself with the lodge and its facilities. Then at about 4:00 pm embark on your first game drive. Your open-sided game vehicle is guided by your ranger, whilst a 'tracker' spots animals from the front of the vehicle. This approach provides visitors with the best opportunity of viewing wildlife up-close and observing features of the reserve that may easily be overlooked. Whilst on safari stop to enjoy a sundowner drink in the bush, before returning to the lodge for dinner in the outdoor boma area or dining area. **Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge - luxury suite (FI).**

Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge

A multi award-winning game lodge, Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge rightly deserves its reputation as one of the finest game lodge's in Africa. Its suites are decorated in a contemporary African style and are exceptionally spacious. From the Nespresso machine, to a port in your room to warm you up after your evening game drive and your private deck looking out to the bush, Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge seems to think of everything. The property has two pools and a spa to tempt you during your down time, a curio shop for those who enjoy retail therapy and large seating areas with views. Meals are served as a sumptuous BBQ banquet in the traditional Boma, or as four to five course meals in the Boma or dining area. Children are especially welcome with a dedicated junior rangers program offered at the Ele Fun Centre. You are assured of viewing plenty of game with Sabi Sabi's experienced rangers and trackers, which are considered amongst the best in the Kruger. Sabi Sabi's concession lies amongst the most abundant wildlife area in Sabi Sand Game Reserve and includes a popular waterhole where guests can enjoy sightings of a range of animals from the main lounge area of the lodge. Recently refurbished, your suite includes a views over the bushveld and luxury furnishings offering comfort and relaxed sophistication.

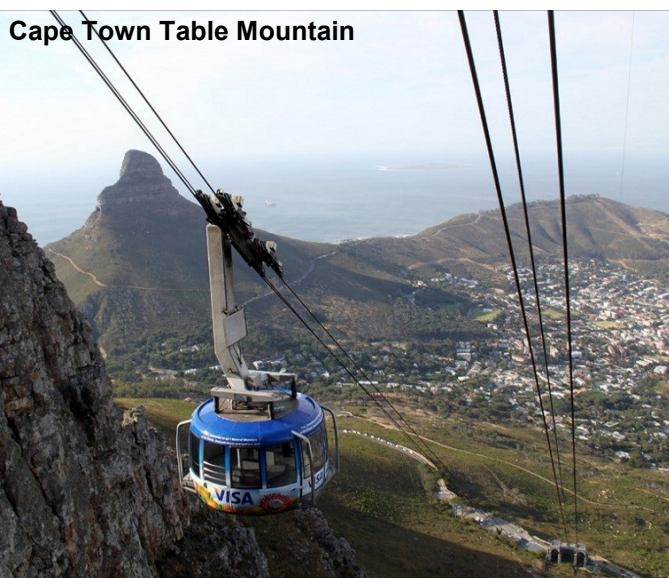
Days 2 & 3: South Africa, Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve

Rise early each day with a wake-up call at about 05:00 am, before you meet for tea and coffee at 05:30 am. After a cuppa you head out on your morning game drive. The fresh morning air in your face as you travel on an open 4WD with the prospect of seeing the 'big five' (lion, leopard, buffalo, rhino, elephant) is an exhilarating experience. Animals are often most active at this time of day and spotting wildlife is guaranteed. Experienced rangers and trackers will share their knowledge of the African bush with you as you enjoy a range of animal sightings. Forming part of the Great Frontier Park, Kruger is an immense 20,000 square kilometers. The park consists of the state-run national park and several land concessions which allow exclusive access to private game lodges.

After your game drive return for breakfast and some time at leisure. You may wish to take a dip in the pool at the lodge, or laze about in the communal lounge overlooking the bush and an active waterhole. After lunch and afternoon tea, set off again on an afternoon game drive to experience wildlife at dusk. This is your opportunity to view the interaction between animals as they search for food. Once back at the lodge, dinner is served. **Sabi Sabi Bush Lodge - luxury suite (FI).**

Day 4: South Africa, Cape Town

Enjoy a final morning game drive in Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve (time permitting), followed by breakfast. After check-out make your way to the lodge reception where you will be met by a representative and road transferred to the airport for your flight to Cape Town (flight not included). Upon arrival at the airport you will be met by a representative and transferred to your hotel.

Day 5: South Africa, Cape Town

This morning after breakfast you will be collected from your hotel foyer by a representative for a shared guided half-day tour of the city. Highlights of the tour include a visit to the Table Mountain cable-car station for a ride up Table Mountain (cableway ticket excluded as weather permitting), the Malay Quarter, city centre, Company Gardens and, time permitting, the Castle of Good Hope.

After the tour return to your hotel and spend the afternoon at leisure. This evening we suggest you dine at one of the numerous restaurants or cafes along the waterfront (own account). **Southern Sun Waterfront - classic room (B).**

Day 6: South Africa, Cape Town

Today enjoy a full day shared tour of Cape Point. Your driver-guide will collect you from the hotel reception. This tour is an ideal way to appreciate the surrounding natural beauty of Cape Town. You will travel along the Atlantic seaboard to Hout Bay, following gorgeous white beaches and rugged mountains. If time permits you have the option of taking a half-hour boat trip to Duiker Island to see a Cape fur seal colony (cost not included). If open, you continue on Chapman's Peak Drive, renowned as one of the most stunning roadways in the world. Visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve at the tip of the Cape Peninsula to view the dramatic surrounding scenery and learn about the point's fascinating history. The return journey to Cape Town takes you along the False Bay coast with the option of visiting the colony of African penguins at Boulders Beach (small entry fee applicable). Pass through the naval village of Simon's Town, Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay and Muizenberg. Finally visit the Rhodes Memorial. After the tour, you will be dropped off at your hotel. Remainder of the day at leisure. **Southern Sun Waterfront - classic room (B).**

Day 7: South Africa, Franschhoek

This morning after breakfast you will be collected from your hotel foyer by a representative and transferred to the quaint Huguenot village of Franschhoek. Situated in the heart of the Cape winelands you spend two days sampling some of the country's best wines and cuisine whilst staying at a traditional Cape Dutch homestead owned by Sir Richard Branson. **Mont Rochelle - Shiraz/Merlot/Cabernet room (B).**

Mont Rochelle, part of the award-winning Virgin Limited Edition collection owned by Sir Richard Branson, is a beautifully refurbished 22-bedroom hotel and vineyard perfectly located a short walk from the centre of Franschhoek. Set on a 100-acre estate, guests unwind in the tranquility of the picturesque setting while enjoying a superb culinary experience accompanied by outstanding wines. There are two restaurants, a cosy bar and lounge, a spa and hammam, a gym, a heated outdoor pool, mountain bikes for guests to use and of course a wine cellar. The room and suite categories are named after the different grapes grown in the region. Shiraz, Merlot and Cabernet rooms have courtyard or valley views, while the Pinotage suites and Cap Classique suites with plunge pools, have a sitting room, a larger terrace and can accommodate families. Miko Restaurant serves gourmet meals and has an adjacent terrace where you will find the friendly decorative sheep. The Country Kitchen is the perfect spot for a light lunch or a relaxed dinner. A favourite lunch for guests is a well-stocked picnic basket, prepared by the in-house chefs, to enjoy in a private spot on the estate.

Day 8: South Africa, Franschhoek

Today is spent exploring the wine estates of Franschhoek on a hop-on, hop-off Wine Tram and bus. This fully restored, historic tram runs on a rail line, stopping at various wineries. A combination of tram and a tram-bus transports passengers around a loop of stops allowing you to hop-off at each stop and experience the activities on offer, be it wine tasting, a cellar tour, lunch (own account), or simply a stroll through the vineyards. Following your Wine Tram experience return to your hotel for dinner, or dine at one of the restaurants in the village (own account). **Mont Rochelle - Shiraz/Merlot/Cabernet room (B).**

Day 9: South Africa, ends

This morning after breakfast you will be collected by a representative and returned to Cape Town airport for your onward arrangements (flight not included). **(B). Ends.**
