Who?

Applicants must be in Years 7-11 at the time of audition. Year 7 students coming to St Clare's in 2026 will have the opportunity to join the cast at the start of Term 1 2026 as part of the Ensemble.

Bring It On heavily involves cheerleading and all cast members will be expected to participate in routines. Please note that this cheer involves stunting and not the pom-pom style. For some cast members this may involve being lifted by members of the company. Cheer experience is not a requirement.

Character Breakdown - Boys

Randall: Jackson's school DJ, mellow and friendly. A true Cinderella story, working his way from a dorky freshman to a smooth senior. He becomes attracted to Campbell for her heart, bravery, and determination.

Steven: The only male cheerleader on the Buccaneers and Campbell's boyfriend. Tender and comforting, but not the most adept to his surroundings.

Cameron: One of the Jackson students, a hip-hop artist. A combination class clown and attempted ladies' man, but he strives for fame and fortune.

Twig: One of the Jackson students and a hip-hop artist. His hormones make him lust after Bridget.

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Round 2 - Callback Audition 1: Thursday, 23rd October 3.30pm - 4.30pm: Acting and Dance Workshop

Students will be required to take part in an acting and dance workshop. Auditionees will read different scenes from the show and be taught a short cheer routine and skills. This will be shown to the panel in small groups

Round 3 - Callback Audition 2: Thursday, 30th October 3.30pm - 4.30pm: Vocal only. Students should sing one of the songs for the character they are most interested in playing. Year 11 students will complete their auditions on an alternative date.

Dance & Acro Ensemble Auditions

Dancers and students with acro skills are needed for this show. Students will be required to take part in a live audition in Week 7 Term 3. Date and time to be confirmed. You will be taught a dance sequence and asked to perform it in a small group. Students with acro skills will also have an opportunity to demonstrate their skills.

Note - All auditionees will be given a place in the cast. In order to proceed to subsequent rounds and to accept a part in the show students must pay the participation fee of \$50 and the fee for the camp in Term 4.

All STCC cast members must attend the 'Learn the Show' Camp in Week 7 Term 4 (Monday, 24th-26th November 2026) Kiah Ridge Christian Conference Centre. Students in Year 11 2025 who wish to be a part of the show can attend the camp if they wish but this is not compulsory for you. Similarly, the camp is optional for boys participating in the show.
